

## Ordering Numbers

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this activity is to order numbers to 31

### **Link to the Number Framework:**

Number Sequence, Stage 3

### **What you need:**

- An old calendar page – with large numbers
- Scissors
- Cardboard (a cereal box, opened up)

### **What to do:**

- Stick the calendar sheet onto the cardboard.
- Cut out the numbers.
- Use numbers to 10, numbers to 20, or all the numbers (depending on the child's ability)
- The child orders the numbers in order. Ask the child to count to check that the numbers are in the correct order.
- The child could put the numbers from biggest to smallest (to practice backwards number counting).
- Ask: *What number will come next? What number would come before?* to prompt the child.

### **What to expect your child to do:**

Know how to sequence numbers to 10, to 20 and to 31.
