### **SBS BANK TOUR OF SOUTHLAND**

The SBS Bank Tour of Southland started on Sunday 29 October 2023 at the Feldwick Gates, Queen's Park at 12:00pm with the 4.2km Prologue for the 67<sup>th</sup> Tour.

This year there are 19 teams competing with 114 riders who will ride the eight stages of the SBS Bank Tour of Southland. The event covers all of Southland including Bluff, Invercargill, Winton, Mossburn, Te Anau, Lumsden, Gore and the Remarkables near Queenstown.

A lot of riders have different skills and win different jerseys at the end of the Tour such as; the King of the Mountain (KoM), Under 23 Leader, Sprint Ace, Silver Jersey and the Most Combative. The overall Tour Leader will wear an orange jersey for the first time this year (instead of a yellow jersey) to recognise its sponsor of 11 years, SBS Bank. Every other year that the Tour has been held, the Tour Leader has worn a yellow jersey.

The final day of the Tour is Saturday 04 November when riders will complete a time trial around Winton before riding all the way from Winton to Invercargill for the finish on Saturday afternoon at around 3:00pm.
